The meeting was called to order by Jack Clark, Chairman.

Ruthe Foster moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Frank Price seconded the motion and it carried.

After reviewing the bills as presented by the accountant, Frank Price moved to transfer \$21,000 from the MMDA to the checking account and pay all bills. Josh Gaines seconded and the motion passed.

The Manager's report included: WTWMA in San Angelo and the Permian Basin Water in Energy Conference in Midland. WTWMA will conduct research on charging existing cloud water droplets when conditions are favorable and continue research with the USDA in using charged water droplets when the seeding season begins. The first annual Permian Basin Water in Energy Conference was held in Midland which focused on water use by the O&G Industry. Presentations were made on the need to for reuse and use of brackish water sources to relieve pressure on fresh drinking water. A panel of three GCD managers representing Culberson, Brewster, Glasscock, Irion and Sterling GCDs discussed the role of GCDs in managing resources.. Well surveillance included: Water levels.

There being no further business, Josh Gaines moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Ruthe Foster and the meeting adjourned at 8:45 A.M.
