- a. All proposed new well locations must be approved by the appropriate water conservation district prior to drilling. This notice of intent to drill may be mailed, emailed, or faxed. The District staff shall review the form and make a preliminary determination on whether the well meets the exemptions provided by district rules and respond to this request within 5 days. If the preliminary determination is that the well is exempt, drilling may begin immediately upon receiving the approved Notice of Intent to Drill. The drilling of a new well is at your own risk and subject to the rules of the District.
- b. It shall be a violation of district rules for a well owner, well operator, or water well driller to drill any well without having first filed and received approval of the Preregistration Notice of Intent to Drill from the appropriate District.
