The meeting was called to order at 1:20 P.M. by Jack Clark, Chairman of the Board.

Ruthe Foster moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Cliff Caldwell seconded the motion and it carried.

After reviewing the bills as presented, Cliff Caldwell moved to transfer \$25,000 from the MMDA to the checking account and to pay all bills. Ruthe Foster seconded, and the motion passed.

The Manager's report included: Access training with RMBJ Geo in Mertzon, TWDB Virtual meeting, TAGD Executive Committee Retreat in Graham, and Congressman Pfluger Townhall in Sterling City. Amy Bush with RMBJGeo spent a day in Mertzon training Ashley and Diana on using Access and reviewing ICWCD data, giving suggestions on how to improve our database efforts. The TWDB Virtual meeting reviewed the Edwards Trinity Model updates and changes from the previous model. The TAGD Executive Committee met in Graham to discuss current organization needs, future direction, and member needs. Issues such as vanity ponds, heavy water users, staff turnover across the state, financial investments, and more were all debated. Congressman Pfluger held a townhall in Sterling City in which he addressed current issues, upcoming elections, and party positions.

After reviewing the proposed DFC and the joint planning process, Ruthe Foster moved to Adopt the Desired Future Condition for the Sterling County Underground Water Conservation District Proposed by the Groundwater Management Area 7. Cliff Caldwell seconded, and the motion passed.
